About the Program

Setsunan University presents its Summer Program on the themes of “Japanese society and culture”. Participants learn core perspectives on Japan, from myths about national identity to various issues in modern society through lectures, field trips, and exchanges with Setsunan students. All the activities are conducted in English.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Currently enrolled in a regular university degree program at the home institution
- English proficiency at the CEFR level of B2 or above

Duration

July 19 to 31 (13 Days)

Accommodation

Student Dormitory, Neyagawa Campus
(3-bedroom apartment to be shared by up to 6 people)

Flight

Participants are responsible for purchasing flight tickets to and from Kansai International Airport (KIX).

Overseas Travel Insurance

Comprehensive Travel insurance is mandatory to cover trip costs, medical care, and lost or stolen property, etc.

Program Fees

JPY 120,000 - 160,000
