- 第一條 南臺科技大學(以下簡稱本校)為鼓勵優秀境外學生就讀本校，特訂定本辦法。
- 第二條 本辦法所稱之境外學生係指符合教育部「外國學生來臺就學辦法」、「僑生回國就學及輔導辦法」、「香港澳門居民來臺就學辦法」、「大陸地區人民來臺就讀專科以上學校辦法」規範之境外學生。
- 第三條 本校設置境外學生獎學金審查小組，研訂及審查本獎學金支領標準、名額及其他相關事宜。小組成員由督導副校長、教務長、學務長、國際事務長、各學院院長組成之。小組由督導副校長擔任召集人，國際事務長擔任執行秘書。
- 第四條 各學制獎學金種類如下：
- 一、大學部：
 - (一) 學雜費全額獎學金。
 - (二) 學雜費半額獎學金。
 - (三) 新生獎學金。
 - 二、碩士班：
 - (一) 學雜費全額獎學金。
 - (二) 學雜費半額獎學金。
 - 三、博士班：
 - (一) 學雜費全額獎學金及提供每月獎學金新台幣10,000 元。
 - (二) 學雜費全額獎學金。
 - (三) 學期間因故出國，當月超過 16 天(含)者，停發當月獎學金新台幣 10,000 元；公假或公差出國者不在此限。
- 第五條 申請者應於線上入學申請系統提出申請，流程說明如下：
- 一、上傳下列申請文件：
 - (一) 學歷證書及歷年成績單
 - (二) 二封推薦信
 - (三) 讀書計畫或研究計畫
 - (四) 自傳
 - (五) 語言檢定證明：全英授課學程需檢附英語成績證明(TOEFL iBT63 或 IELTS5.0 或多益 650 分(含)以上)或前段學歷畢業學校開立之英語授課證明，中文授課學程須檢附相當於華語文能力測驗(TOCFL)(基礎級)A2(含)以上之中文能力證明。
 - (六) 馬來西亞學生需檢附統一考試成績(UEC)、SPM 或STPM
 - 二、春季班申請截止日為 11 月 30 日，審查結果於 12 月 25 日於線上入學申請系統公告。秋季班申請截止日為 5 月 15 日，審查結果於 6 月 10 日在線上入學申請

系統公告。

- 第六條 符合獎學金申請資格者，其獎學金於每學期第 13 週核發。其中，學雜費半額獎學金如計算後產生非整數金額時，採四捨五入至整數位計算。
- 第七條 獲得本校獎學金之新生，須於開學前至國際暨兩岸事務處辦理報到並參加新生訓練，始可領取本校獎學金；若未能於時間內完成報到及參加新生訓練，視同放棄受獎資格。若因簽證問題而無法參加新生訓練，須於正式上課日起兩週內完成報到，始得領取該學期之本校獎學金。
- 第八條 獲得本辦法獎學金之大學部學生，自入學第二學期起，應於每學期正式上課日起二週內，向國際暨兩岸事務處報到，始得繼續領取當學期獎學金；若未能於時間內完成報到，視同放棄受獎資格。
- 自入學第二學期起，於每學期正式上課日起二週內，檢附前一學期成績單向國際暨兩岸事務處申請續領該學期之本校獎學金，續領審查標準如下：
- 一、僑生與大學部全英語授課學士學位學程
學雜費全額、半額獎學金：前一學期學業平均成績達班級排名前 50%者可續領獎學金。
 - 二、大學部中文授課學程
學雜費全額、半額獎學金：前一學期學業平均成績達班級排名前 20%者可續領獎學金。
- 第九條 獲得本辦法獎學金之碩士及博士學生，入學後第二學期起，於每學期正式上課日起二週內，檢附前一學期成績單向國際暨兩岸事務處申請續領該學期之本校獎學金，續領審查標準如下：
- 一、博士班學生須於入學當學期結束前確認指導教授人選，學業平均成績須達 80 分(含)或 GPA 3.38(含)以上，及指導教授考核通過。未符前述條件者，每月獎學金新臺幣 10,000 元將予以取消。若情況特殊，簽核准後不在此限。
 - 二、碩士班學生：
 - (一)學雜費半額獎學金：
 - 1.前一學期學業平均成績達及格標準。
 - 2.成績未達上述標準者，將取消受獎資格，爾後成績達上述標準，得提出申請恢復續領獎學金。
 - (二)學雜費全額獎學金：
 - 1.碩士班學生學業平均成績平均分數須達 80 分(含)或 GPA 3.38 (含)以上。
 - 2.若未通過學雜費全額獎學金申請者，則依學雜費半額標準審查。爾後學期達學雜費全額獎學金標準，得再續領學雜費全額獎學金。
- 第十條 獲得本辦法獎學金之大學部轉學生，續領審查標準同第八條，惟獲獎期間，轉入二年級者，獎學金最多核給三年，轉入三年級者，獎學金最多核給二年。
- 第十一條 領取本獎學金就讀大學部者最多獎勵入學後前四年，就讀碩士班者最多獎勵入學後二年，就讀博士班者最多獎勵入學後三年，若有特殊原因，得簽請校長核定後辦理，不受上述獎勵年限的限制。獎學金名額視當年度本校獎學金預算而定。若受獎學生提前畢業，立即停止受獎資格。
- 第十二條 已領取「臺灣獎學金」、外國政府獎學金(如：「湄公 1000 專案計畫獎學金」、「菁英來臺留學計畫獎學金」等)或由本校、校外核發之其他獎學金者，不得重複領取本獎學金；若發現重複領取者，本校將追回已領取之獎學金。
- 第十三條 受核定獎勵之學生如發生下列情事之一，立即取消其獎助資格。
- 一、提供不確實入學申請資料者，本校將追回已領取之獎學金並予退學。
 - 二、未完成註冊或轉學離校者。
 - 三、學期中途休、退學者。

四、前各學期未依規定繳清學雜費或積欠各種費用者。

五、被記小過(含)以上者。

第十四條 本辦法經行政會議通過後，陳請校長核定後，自 116 學年度起公布施行，修正時亦同。

Article 1

The STUST Scholarship Establishment Regulations for Overseas Students (hereinafter referred to as "the STUST SERIS") are established to encourage outstanding Overseas Students to study at Southern Taiwan University of Science and Technology (STUST).

Article 2

The term "overseas students" as referred to in these regulations shall mean students who meet the qualifications set forth in the Ministry of Education's 「 Regulations Regarding International Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan 」 , 「 Regulations Regarding Study and Counseling Assistance for Overseas Compatriot Students in Taiwan 」 , 「 Regulations Regarding Hong Kong and Macao Residents Undertaking Studies in Taiwan 」 , and 「 Regulations Governing Mainland Area Students Undertaking Studies in Taiwan 」 .

Article 3

The Scholarship Review Committee is set up to initiate and review the criteria for awarding this scholarship, finalize the number of recipients, and deal with other relevant issues. Members consists of Supervising Vice President, Dean of Academic Affairs, Dean of Student Affairs, Dean of International Affairs, and Deans from all the colleges. Supervising Vice President serves as the Chairperson, and Dean of International Affairs as the Executive Secretary.

Article 4

Types of Scholarship for different programs of study

1. Undergraduate:

- (1) Full tuition scholarship.
- (2) Half tuition scholarship.
- (3) New student scholarship.

2. Master:

- (1) Full tuition scholarship.
- (2) Half tuition scholarship.

3. Ph.D. :

- (1) Full tuition scholarship , and a stipend of 10,000 TWD per month.
- (2) Full tuition scholarship.
- (3) If you go abroad for some reason during the semester with a duration of more than 16 days

(inclusive), your monthly scholarship of NT\$10,000 will be suspended. Those who go abroad on official leave or business trips are not restricted.

Article 5

Applicants should apply through the Online Application and Status Inquiry System. The procedures are as follows:

1. Upload the following application documents:

(1) Photocopies of original graduation diploma and official transcript

(2) Two reference letters

(3) Study plan or research proposal

(4) Autobiography

(5) Certificate of Language Proficiency: English-taught programs require an English-language certificate (such as TOEFL iBT score of 63 or above, IELTS score of 5.0 or above, or TOEIC score of 650 or above) or a certificate from the previous institution stating that the language of instruction was English; Chinese-taught programs require a Chinese proficiency certificate, equivalent to the Test of Chinese proficiency (TOCFL)(Basic Level) A2 or above is required.

(6) United Examination Certificate (UEC), SPM or STPM (only required for Malaysian students)

2. The application deadline for the spring semester is November 30, and the results will be published on the online application system on December 25. The application deadline for the fall semester is May 15, and the results will be published on the online application system on June 10.

Article 6.

Scholarships for eligible applicants will be awarded in the 13th week of each semester. For Half tuition scholarships, if the calculated amount is not a whole number, it will be rounded to the nearest whole number.

Article 7

New students who receive this award are required to report at the Office of International Affairs and attend the orientation BEFORE the semester starts. If recipients fail to report or attend the orientation before the semester starts, their award for the semester will be cancelled. If recipients are not able to attend the orientation due to VISA issues, they are required to report within 2 weeks after the classes begin, or the award will be cancelled.

Article 8

Starting from the SECOND semester after admission, currently enrolled undergraduate students who have received the scholarship are required to report within 2 weeks after the classes begin to continue receiving the scholarship for that semester. Failure to report within the designated time frame will be regarded as an abandonment of the scholarship eligibility.

Starting from SECOND semester after admission, submit transcripts from the previous semester to the Office of International Affairs within two weeks after the classes begin for renewal verification.

The review criteria for renewal are as follows:

1. Overseas Compatriot Students and Undergraduate English-taught Programs

Full tuition and Half tuition scholarship: Students whose average academic performance in the previous semester ranked in the top 50% of their class are eligible for a continuation of the scholarship.

2. Undergraduate Chinese-taught Programs

Full tuition and Half tuition scholarship: Students whose average academic performance in the previous semester ranked in the top 20% of their class are eligible for a continuation of the scholarship.

Article 9

Starting from the SECOND semester after admission, current enrolled master and Ph.D. students who have received the scholarship are required to submit transcripts from the previous semester to the Office of International Affairs within two weeks after the class begin for renewal verification. The review criteria for renewal are as follows:

1. Ph.D. students must select and advisor prior to the end of the first semester in the program, maintain a minimum GPA 3.38 out of 4.3 (80 out of 100), pass the evaluation of their supervising advisor. Entitlement to the stipend of NT\$10,000 monthly will be cancelled if recipients fail to meet the listed requirements. Students that fail to meet requirements can apply for special considerations for other extenuating circumstances. The stipend will be reinstated if the application is approved by the President.

2. Master's students:

(1) Half tuition scholarship:

- i. Students should maintain a minimum GPA 2.44 out of 4.3 (70 out of 100).
- ii. Students who fail to maintain the above academic criteria will be disqualified from receiving the scholarship. Once their academic performance meets the above criteria in the subsequent semester, they may apply to have the scholarship reinstated.

(2) Full tuition scholarship:

- i. Students should maintain a minimum GPA 3.38 out of 4.3 (80 out of 100).
- ii. Students who failed to get the full tuition waiver will be considered for the half tuition waiver. When students qualify again in subsequent semester, the full tuition waiver will be reinstated.

Article 10

Undergraduate transfer students who receive scholarships under this regulation will be subject to the same review criteria as in Article 8. However, during the period of receiving the scholarship, those who transfer to the second year will be granted the scholarship for a maximum of three years, and those who transfer to the third year will be granted the scholarship for a maximum of two years.

Article 11

The maximum length for a recipient to receive this scholarship after enrollment is the first four years

for an undergraduate students, the first two years for master's students and the first three years for Ph.D. students. If students have special reasons, their application needs to be approved by the President. The number of scholarship recipients will be based on STUST's budget for the current academic year. If the recipients graduate early, their scholarship will be terminated immediately.

Article 12

Those recipients who have received a Taiwan Scholarship, foreign governmental scholarships (such as Mekong 1000 Project Scholarship, Elite Study in Taiwan Scholarship, etc.) or other scholarships issued by STUST or other universities will not be eligible to receive this award. If it is discovered that any students are receiving scholarships in addition to this award, they will have to choose one and return the award given.

Article 13

The award will be terminated immediately when recipients:

1. Provide fake application materials, for which the recipients are demanded to return the award given and then would be expelled.
2. Transfer to other schools/universities or fail to complete the registration process.
3. Apply for suspension, withdrawal, or dismissal from STUST.
4. Defer tuition payment and other fees from the previous semester.
5. To be cited with minor demerits and above.

Article 14

These Regulations were officially approved at the STUST's Administrative Meeting, promulgated by the President, and implemented starting from the Fall Semester of 2027. Any amendments will undergo the same process.

※ In case of discrepancies between the Chinese and English versions of this scholarship regulations, the Chinese version shall prevail.
