Southeast Asia - MOE Elite Scholarship in 2027 Fall semester	
Eligibility	International students who are Doctoral/Master's degree-seeking applicants and are currently university lecturers or professors in Indonesia, Philippines, Thailand, Vietnam, India, Malaysia, Singapore, Brunei, Myanmar, Cambodia, Laos, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Bhutan, are eligible to apply. *Up-to-date Lecturer Certificate (English version) is required. *If the applicant is not from a sister school of our university, please provide proof of the world university ranking of the institution where you are employed.
Study Year	Commencing from the 2027 Fall Semester only.
Application Time	◆ Complete the quota application form via Google Forms (https://forms.gle/zrfBxRu7abZwbxn27) Deadline: October 30, 2026 ◆ Apply for the Fall semester programs for international students at STUST. Deadline: January 2027 to May 15, 2027
Apply for <u>2027 Fall Semester Admission</u> at https://portal.stust.edu.tw/intstudweb/Login.aspx * The admission application will be evaluated by the department. * Applicants are required to choose the Full English Taught Programs. * The applicant is required to submit the <u>up-to-date Lecturer Certificate</u> again after receiving admission. The scholarship application will be reviewed and determined by the MOE.	
Duration of Scholarships	3 years for Ph.D. programs (reviewed annually); 2 years for Master's programs (reviewed annually) * Must complete the enrollment procedures every semester to receive the two/three-year continuous scholarship.
Amount of Scholarship	NTD 300,000 per year (approx. USD 10,000 per year; exchange rate: NTD to USD is approx. 30 to 1) * The amount of the Elite scholarship is issued by MOE. It will be NTD 25,000 per month, which is used as funding for tuition and credit fees, and the rest amount will be used as a monthly stipend to support study and living in STUST.

Remarks	Students may not apply if they: - Hold Taiwan (R.O.C.) nationality or have the status of an overseas Chinese student. - Are enrolled or have retained admission to a university in Taiwan. (This restriction does not apply to students who are on course to graduate and will be pursuing their next degree; however, they must still be lecturers from a South or Southeast Asian country.) - Previously studied in Taiwan for a degree at the same level. - Are exchange students or dual-degree students through a partnership agreement with an institution overseas. - Have already received stipends through this program for more than three years. - Have received scholarships from foreign governmental institutions or from a Taiwan (R.O.C.) government agency to support their studies in Taiwan. Note: Recipients are NOT allowed to receive the STUST Distinguished International Student Scholarship during the offered period of this scholarship. Recipients should have completed the enrollment procedures each semester in order to receive a continuous stipend for their studies in Taiwan. Scholarship will be canceled if recipients apply for a deferment or suspension, or are expelled from their enrolled programs.
